Immigration Practitioner Program (IPP) graduates will continue to be authorized to write the ICCRC licensing exam for up to 3 years after graduating from the IPP. Candidates who do not successfully pass the EPE by February 6, 2022 may use their remaining attempts (up to a total of 4 attempts) to write the new licensing exam within the 3-year validity period of their IPP transcript.
