WHAT

The Managing an Immigration Consulting Practice (MICP) course is designed to support new Regulated Canadian Immigration Consultants (RCICs) in starting up their immigration consulting practice, maintaining competency, and building goodwill and reputation. Throughout the course, RCICs will:

1. Examine the Council's requirements for managing an immigration consulting practice,
2. Listen to the stories of RCICs, and

- a) are new members (i.e., joined the Council after March 1, 2013) and
- b) own an immigration consulting practice (e.g., sole proprietorship, corporation, etc.).
