

Statement of Facts

Martin Francis Nagendra (Sam) Selliah

Burlington (ON) – May 14, 2014 – There have been reports in the media that allegations made against Martin Francis Nagendra (Sam) Selliah 'Mr. Selliah' as part of the Immigration Consultants of Canada Regulatory Council (ICCRC) Complaints and Discipline process have been dismissed. Further, there have been reports that the ICCRC provided Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC) with specific information regarding Mr. Selliah. These reports are incorrect.

The ICCRC By-Law and the rules of procedure of the Discipline Committee provide Panels of the Discipline Committee with the authority to approve or reject settlement agreements between the ICCRC and members who are subject to formal complaints.

As set out in the Disciplinary Decisions section of the ICCRC website, the Complaints against Mr. Selliah have been resolved. In accordance with the ICCRC By-Law and the rules of procedure of the Discipline Committee, the resolution was reviewed and approved by a Panel of the Discipline Committee, namely that Mr. Selliah's ICCRC membership was voluntarily and permanently withdrawn, effective April 30, 2014.

As a result of Mr. Selliah having voluntarily and permanently withdrawn from ICCRC membership, he is no longer authorized by the ICCRC to practice as a Regulated Canadian Immigration Consultant (RCIC).
